

I am a French citizen and a convinced European with roots in Brittany. The family of my husband is established in England for generations, and we married in London.

I know the life of an expatriate having lived in London; how difficult it is to leave France, and even more to re-enter the French system (tax, formalities etc). It is time to make the life of expatriates easier, as France needs you to expand its economy and culture. Therefore I want France to extend rights to its expatriates, to adopt a regime of urgent financial aid when its citizens live in countries that are undergoing an economic crisis and to adopt services (including vote to the elections) on internet.

I have a PhD (doctorat) in International Business Law from the University Paris-1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, with research at Oxford and LSE) and an Avocat à la Cour de Paris.

I practiced law in Paris and London for several years working for top international firms like Clifford Chance and Allen & Overy, and was a registered European lawyer at Law Society of England & Wales. I am always moved when I see the projects I contributed to like EuroTunnel, Stade de France, airports in Europe and Asia, renewable energy projects in Europe and South America.

I have also worked in the Aerospace & Technology industry for 9 years, contributing to the expansion of the European Aerospace industry. I have advised on emblematic aerospace projects with Airbus, Thales, Embraer (Brazil) and Irkut (Russia). Notably, I worked for Dassault, and was on the Board of Directors of a Swedish Aerospace Company.

At the beginning of my career, I lectured business law for five years at the University Paris-1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, and was a member of the Board of Directors of the Sorbonne. I worked on missions with the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs in the Baltic States to adapt their financial laws to meet European Union requirements. This experience in the UK, Sweden and the Baltic States explains my interest for this constituency.

I speak frequently at conferences across Europe on a wide range of international issues (anti-corruption, environment, financing), and publish regularly on Project Finance.

I believe investment in research on high-technology, and communication systems, like the Internet and networks, will spur innovation and cooperation, create new jobs, and build a better world, including better medicines, and spread culture, such as art, far and wide.

Art and literature are inspiration that invigorates me. As Picasso said "art washes away from the soul the dust of everyday life". I always find time to visit museums, and some of my favorites are the British Museum, Tate Modern, in London, the Louvre and Musée d'Orsay in Paris and the Prado Museum in Madrid. I also like to discover new artists in private exhibitions and support them.

I speak to many of you and hear of your lives; the good parts and those areas that need improvement. They are inspiration for this program, because they reinforce my desire to innovate, creating concrete solutions that will improve our lives. We cannot wait for the classical political parties who have failed to bring solutions, basically because they are disconnected from real life. They ignore the real problems that people face (employment issues, cost of living, school fees, taxation, retirement, administrative matters, etc). Their major proposal is to raise taxes especially for French citizens abroad and I am against it.

As I am a lawyer I am equipped to defend you, so that you realize your rewards and potential, and are able to move, with your family, your investment, your retirement, easily across Europe. As I am an independent candidate, I am dedicated to your interests and your interests exclusively. I can defend your interests at the National Assembly directly without the veto of any party before the debate.
